Congressman Roy Blunt announces \$5,000 donation to Ozarks Food Harvest from Target

SPRINGFIELD (Nov. 11, 2009)—Congressman Roy Blunt along with Target team members presented a \$5,000 donation from Target to Ozarks Food Harvest today at The Food Bank in North Springfield. The funding will enable Ozarks Food Harvest to distribute an additional \$50,000 worth of food items for The Food Bank's *Feeding Families* Initiative, according to Ozarks Food Harvest's President/CEO Bart Brown.
